We are learning...

Science: Building on what they learned about fossils in Year 3, children find out more about how living things have changed over time. They will be introduced to the idea that characteristics are passed from parent to their offspring, but that they are not exactly the same. Children will look at evolution and Charles' Darwin's theory of natural selection, as well as palaeontologist Mary Anning's work with fossils.

Geography: Children will consider if we are damaging our world and how we can protect it. The children will investigate energy production, the oceans and minerals, as well as conducting an enquiry into how the school can become more sustainable.

Computing: In this unit, pupils produce a school magazine using desktop publishing tools. They source, write, edit and combine images and text from a range of sources.

RE: We will be exploring the connections between religious teachings and religious charities.

PSHE: We will look at how to respect ourselves and others.

Music: Using two new pieces, Bacharach Anorak and Meet The Blues, the pupils will learn to play the pieces and then explore improvising with the repertoire.
