Please take out earrings before school.




Reading Books



We are learning...

Writing

This term our class reading book is Harry Potter & The Philosophers Stone.

Our Writing genres are:

- Biography
- Adventure Narrative
- Persuasive letter
- Non-Chronological Report

Reading

This term we will be looking at a mix of fiction and non-fiction texts and focusing on the reading domains of Retrieval, Word Meaning, Inference, Summarize and Predict.

Maths

This term we will include continuing practice, on four operations +, -, x and ÷, fractions, percentages, tricky columns, geometric facts and reasoning.

Geography

This term we will research and understand how regions of the UK have changed over time.

Design & Technology

This term we are learning about bridges and structures.

RE

This term we are learning when, how and why Christians pray.

Computing

This term we will be investigating early methods of communication over distances.

Family Challenge

Our Geography lessons will be looking at 'Change in our Environment'.
