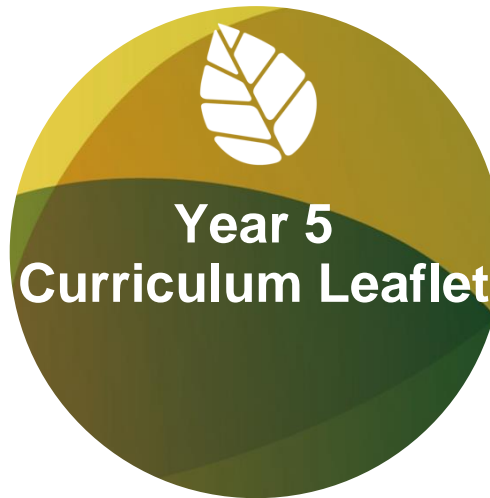
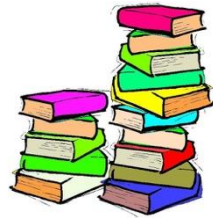
Reading Books
