

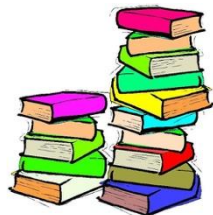
PE Day

We are learning...

Maths: Children will continue to learn how to read and write numbers to 20 and add and subtract within 20. They will start to learn their number bonds to 10 and 20. They will also learn about halves and quarters.

Writing: Our focus this term will be on a range of features: speech bubbles, setting and character descriptions, recount and much more. We will also be writing our own sentences correctly using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. Children will also be encouraged to use their RWI sound mat and Fred Fingers to spell words.

Science: Children will be learning to say which body part is associated with each sense, distinguish between an object and the material it is made from. Identify everyday materials and identify basic structures of plants.

History: Children will be what life was like when their grandparents were their age. Children will compare schools, toys etc.

RE: Children will be learning more about Christian beliefs and discuss the characteristics of God.

D&T - To be able to make and evaluate a food product based on a design.

PSHE: To recognise the importance of families and those who look after us.
