We are learning...

Science: The topic introduces the concept of light travelling in straight lines. It starts by looking at beams of light and how light travels to enable children to understand how we see things. This understanding is then applied to the production of shadows and starts to look at how light is reflected. The topic then takes the learning into the realm of coloured light and rainbows, using scientific skills to raise and answer questions.

History: In this unit, the children will learn about aspects of political, social and cultural Ancient Greek life. They will focus on some areas in depth, such as the systems of government, religion and the importance of the Olympic Games. They will examine the legacy of the Ancient Greeks, and will have opportunities for further study of areas of interest.

Computing: In this unit, pupils use a blogging platform to explore issues related to social media.

RE: We will be exploring the connections between religious teachings and religious charities.

PSHE: We will look at how to respect ourselves and others.

Music: All the learning in this unit is focused around one song: You've Got A Friend by Carole King
