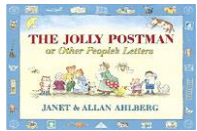


# Reception Summer 2 Curriculum Leaflet

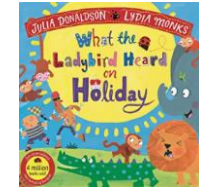
