

Year 4 Summer 2 Curriculum Leaflet

ENGLISH

In English, Year 4 are going to be looking at the famous author Jacqueline Wilson. They are going to learn about the author and create a piece of text around her.

Children will also be looking at The London Eye Mystery and working on creating a mystery narrative, newspaper report and non-chronological report.

PSHE

In PSHE, our topic is 'Changing Me'.

We will be exploring the many way our lives and bodies change as we grow up. We will also be creating strategies for dealing with change when it happens.



DT

In DT, our topic is 'Seasonal Food'. As part of this topic, the children will be looking at a range of recipes and exploring how we can use seasonal foods available to us in different healthy recipes. We will also be learning how to measure ingredients and combine them to complete a recipe.

MATHS

During the first two weeks of the half term, the children will be completing the Multiplication Tables Check. This check will test the children on a range of times tables, 2 – 12, and is scored out of 25 marks. Please continue to practice your times tables in preparation.

In arithmetic, we will be focusing on negative numbers, multiplying large numbers and long division. We will also introduce the new concept of algebra, using x and y to complete maths stories.

In geometry, the children will be exploring the properties of shapes and angles, including using a protractor.

In data and measure, we will be looking at time and converting between hours, minutes and seconds. We will also look at converting units of length and mass, which will be very useful in our DT topic.

RE

RE this half term is going to be all about Learning from Islam. This unit will enable children to understand the significance of the five Pillars of Islam, and to reflect on the sources of strength in their own lives.

COMPUTING

The children will be looking at the different ways we track and measure weather and how this can be recorded and analysed using data management software.

HISTORY

In History, children will explore how and why Crime and Punishment has changed over time. They will use a variety of sources to understand the different time periods. Children will learn about the Bloody Code of 1815, the founding of the first police force, transportation of prisoners and the activism of the Suffragettes.
