ENGLISH

Our class text for this term is Over The Line by Tom Palmer. It is a historical fiction book. which combines the subjects of football and WW1. We will be finishing our year by revising all the skills needed to write a range of texts, including: a letter, a newspaper report, a setting description, a biography, and a balanced argument. In Reading this term, we will be reading a range of fiction and nonfiction texts and continue to concentrate on answering Inference and Summary questions.

Our focus will be Relationships, in particular our relationship with technology and online gaming. We will be discussing whv games have age restrictions, what our personal qualities are, what it means to be a part of an online community and why we should limit our time using technology.



Design & **Technology**
