ENGLISH

In Writing, Year 3 will be using the book 'Cats Ahoy' by Peter Bently. We will be using this to write character and setting descriptions and an alternative ending. We will also write some shape poetry and a non-chronological report about cats.

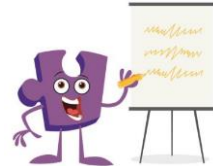
We will also use 'The Day The Crayons Quit' by Oliver Jeffers to write a letter.

We will focus on using punctuation correctly and using adjectives, adverbs and conjunctions in our writing.

PSHE

In PSHE year 3 will be looking at unit 1 – 'Being me in my world'.

Year 3 will contribute to our whole-school Learning Charter by getting to know each other.



ART

In art year 3 will create and print using a printing block inspired by William Morris.



MATHS

In maths year 3 will be working through units 1-5:

Unit 1 - Recognise the place value of each digit (up to 4 digits).

Unit 2 - Add and subtract multiples of 10 100 and 1000.

Unit 3 - Add and subtract up to 2-digit numbers using an efficient method.

Unit 4 - Vertical addition and subtraction up to 3-digit numbers with tricky tens or ones columns.

Unit 5 - Interpret data in tables and pictograms.

RE

In RE year 3 will be learning about what do people believe about God? (Christianity). At the end of unit 1, year 3 will be able to express their own thoughts about God.

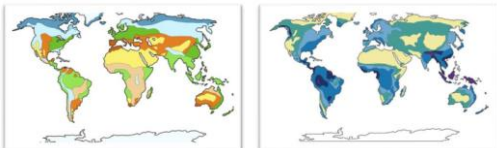


COMPUTING

In computing year 3 will learn to program an animation as part of our unit 1 – we are programmers.
