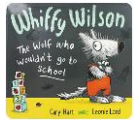


Reception Curriculum Leaflet

6th September

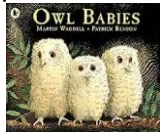
'Whiffy Wilson: The Wolf Who Wouldn't go to School,' by Caryl Hart and Leonie Lord.

This week we will learning about different people in school who help us. We will be visiting our chef, the school office, the headteacher and site manager to learn about what they do in school.

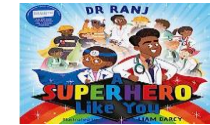
23rd October
