

# Year 6 Autumn 2 Curriculum Leaflet

## ENGLISH

During English lessons children will be reading a range of list poems. They will be discussing the different structural and language features and will be exploring a range of text features such as metaphors, similes, alliteration, and the impact they have on the reader.

Children will also be looking at a Mayan Myth. They will unpick the text to look at the setting, characters and how to develop a good adventure story. There will be particular focus on tenses: ensuring children are using the correct tense throughout the story.

## PSHE

We will look at how to respect ourselves and others.



## DT

This half term, children will be taking part in developing their own classroom model. Focussing heavily on the design and make processes.

## MATHS

In maths lessons children will be looking at methods to multiply, divide, add and subtract and will be applying them to problems. We will also be looking at the area of ratio and will be exploring fractions too.

Children will also be looking at graphs and the data they provide us with.

In geometry, we will be looking at shapes and how they can be 'transformed'.

## RE

We will be exploring how to make our community a more respectful place.
