

Year 4 Autumn 2 Curriculum Leaflet

ENGLISH

In English, we will be focusing on the story of 'Flat Stanley and The Great Egyptian Grave Robbery, which links to our History topic – Ancient Egyptians. We will be:

- Writing a non-chronological report on pyramids and mummies.
- Write a newspaper report.
- Create a Christmas narrative.
- Create a biography about a famous author.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be working with the Wolfe Foundation coaches this half term. They will deliver lessons for the children on problem solving, teamwork and listening to each other.



DT

In DT, we will be making seasonal decorations. We will work using different fabrics and decorative extras, a range of different stitches, and embroidery. The children will create their design based on the needs of their consumer, targeted at a specific group.

MATHS

In maths, we will be working on a range of topics, building on the learning we have already done this year. This will include:

- Multiple step word problems
- Calculating with money
- Measuring angles using protractors
- Calculating the perimeter and area of rectilinear shapes
- Analysing data in charts and pictograms
- Using multiplication facts to solve maths stories

The children will also continue working on multiplication tables, as they prepare for the multiplication tables check in the summer term.

RE

In RE, we will be looking at Christianity and our key question is: Why do some people think Jesus is inspirational? To aid our learning in RE, we will be looking at stories from the Bible and look at different ways that Jesus is portrayed. We will also be looking into what Christian people believe about Jesus.

COMPUTING

In computing, the children will expand on the coding techniques they have learned on scratch and apply this to create programs for the micro bit software. We will be working on random number and symbol generators and creating their own projects to share with their classmates.

HISTORY

In History, we will be looking into the Ancient Egyptians and our key question is: How much did the Ancient Egyptians Achieve? Children will explore who the Ancient Egyptians were, what they did, and discuss whether Ancient Egypt deserves its reputation as one of the most important early civilisations.

MUSIC



Miss Rakhra's class will be learning new notes using the glockenspiel and musical theory about pitch, rhythm and melody. Mr Vawer's class will continue learning the ukelele.

SCIENCE

Our Science topic this half term is: What's that sound? We are going to be looking into what makes sound, through observing varieties of sounds and create experiments to test sound. We will also investigate finding patterns between the volume of a sound and how it is made.
