ENGLISH

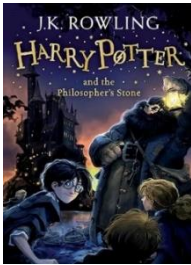
This term our class reading book is Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone.
