

Year 1 Autumn 2 Curriculum Leaflet

ENGLISH

This term we are writing some character descriptions based 'Stick Man' by Julia Donaldson and 'Leaf Man' by Louia Ehlert. We will also be creating a spider fact file and recounting our trip to West Midlands Safari Park.

We will be building our writing skills by introducing the conjunctions 'and' as well as 'because' when children are ready. All children will be applying their reading skills in writing and are expected to use their known phonics sounds in their writing.

PSHE

This term we are celebrating differences. We are looking at how we are similar to our friends but what makes us unique and special.

We are going to be learning about bullying; what bullying is and who we can talk to when we are feeling unhappy or worried.



DT

Our DT topic this term is 'Eat More Fruit and Vegetables.'

The children will be tasting, cutting, and creating their very own fruit and vegetable salad. We will talk about hygiene and safety when cooking. The children will also be looking at identifying and describing familiar fruits and vegetables.

MATHS

This term we are continuing to add and subtract from 20. We are going to be using concrete objects, pictorial, and abstract resources to deepen our learning.

We are also learning embellished maths stories and word problems to help us to identify the maths story hidden in a word problem.

In shape, space and measure we will be recognising coins, notes and learning how to tell the time.

In our daily practice we will be learning our 2's and 5's times tables, as well as many different skills that will help our learning in maths.

RE

This term we are learning all about Sikhism. At the end of this topic the children will be able to use religious words to talk about artefacts and symbols important to Sikhs.

COMPUTING
