

Year 1 Summer 1 Curriculum Leaflet

ENGLISH

In writing this term, we will be focusing on developing a range of skills.

We will be creating riddles, speech bubbles, character descriptions and recounting our trip.

Our main focus is to continue using our capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. As well as using conjunctions to add detail to our writing.

PSHE

The children will be working with Wolves Foundation, learning about ways we can keep ourselves physically and mentally healthy. They will learn about the benefits of teamwork, a range of physical activities and how they can make healthy food choices.



ART

We will be looking at a range of skills to create a self-portrait. We will be creating simple collages, using a range of pencil techniques, and manipulating clay. We will be learning a range of skills to support our final art project of creating a clay self-portrait.

MATHS

In Summer 1 we will be consolidating our knowledge on place value with some children being more secure in reading and writing number to 999.

We later move onto adding by counting on and understanding its better to start with the larger number. In subtracting we move to doing this under 20.

Finally, we finish this half term by continuing vertical addition as well as spending a lot of this term introducing vertical subtraction.

You can help your child in Maths by practicing simple addition and subtraction at home under 20.

RE

In RE this half term we will be introducing children to Hinduism and ask the question, What do Hindus Celebrate? Children will be introduced to the basic Hindu beliefs study the wonderful Hundi festivals,
