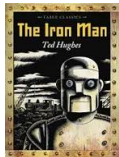


# Year 3 Summer 2 Curriculum Leaflet

## ENGLISH

In our writing lessons Year 3 will be using *The Iron Man*, by Ted Hughes. The children will be writing a variety of texts including a setting description, diary entry, interview and then a recount of our trip to Weston Super-Mare. We will also be reading some of *The Iron Man* in our reading lessons.



## PSHE

In PSHE Year 3 we are focussing on relationships. We will be looking at family roles and responsibilities, friendships, keeping safe online and how to be a good citizen.



## DT

In Design and Technology, we will be looking at light up signs. Year 3 will then connect components to control an LED.



## MATHS

In Maths, Year 3 will be using our knowledge of adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing and applying these skills to multi-step word problems. We will be looking using scales to measure both weight and volume. Children will be using their number knowledge to solve number pattern, puzzles and word problems. Year 3 will be finding the perimeter of squares and rectangles. As well as this, children will be looking at and interpreting a range of different data such as bar charts and pictograms. Children will also collect their own data and record it in an appropriate manner. We will also be recognising acute, obtuse and right angles.

## RE

In RE, children will be learning about Islam. We will be exploring what is important to Muslims as well as how the celebrate a variety of different ceremonies such as naming ceremonies, marriage and funerals.
