Year 5 – Sport Day – 9th July


ENGLISH

Our Year 5 text is 'Over the Line' by Tom Palmer. Our Writing Lessons will explore:

- Biography
- Flashback narrative.
- Newspaper report

Our Reading lessons will concentrate on reading domains of:

- Word meaning
- Retrieval
- Inference
- Summary/giving opinions



PSHE

MATHS

This term we will include: Solving comparison, sum and difference problems with line graphs, complete missing number girds and sequences, estimate and compare angles and identify and use square and cube numbers.

FKENCH

speaking, listening, and writing skills. We will learn about giving dates of my birthday, zoo animals and my likes and dislikes. I will be able to form plurals in French and produce a poster using Key French Phrases from this year.

RE

This term, we will be looking at different religions and beliefs within our community. We will be looking at the Jewish community, the atheist communities, and the prominent religions in the community.

HISTORY

In this unit, children will find out about journeys. We will be looking at the Titanic, looking at why the Kindertransport occurred and why people undertake these different journeys. The children will look at positives and negatives of these different journeys.
