

Year 6 Summer 2 Curriculum Leaflet

ENGLISH

In writing, children will be consolidating their learning by producing several different genres of writing, for example a newspaper report based around a 'twisted tale'. A narrative: 'The dream giver'. A persuasive leaflet/blog and finally, an interview with an author.

In Reading, we will be exploring a range of texts and understanding how the author creates suspension and mood within these.

PSHE

This half term, children will be learning about their strengths and set challenging but realistic goals for themselves while recognising what praise looks like and develop admiration for others.



DT

Children will look at a variety of different bird houses and discuss the differences in appearance, their functions, and what types of birds they attract before designing and constructing their own Birdcages.

MATHS

During our final half term, children will prepare themselves for secondary school. Learning key skills to give them the foundation for success as they transition to secondary school.

There will be a heavy focus on algebraic questions, fractions, angles and data handling.

We will also be looking at exploring open ended investigations to challenge the children's reasoning skills.

RE

In RE, children will be discussing and exploring what matters most. Focusing on Christian and Humanists beliefs of right and wrong.
