## ENGLISH

In writing, will explore poetry with Pep the Poet visiting us. Children will get a chance to perform their piece of poetry.

We will be writing some diary entries as well as recounts of events that are due to happen this half term.

We will also be creating a narrative based on the text Dog Man,

## PSHE

In PSHE, our topic this half term is on Relationships.

Our lessons will explore themes of jealousy, friendships, helping others to feel part of a group as well as showing respect in how we treat others.



## Art

Art this half term focus is on the artist Sonia Delaunay.

Children will become familiar with the early life and artwork of Sonia Delaunay. They will learn the influence and legacy of Sonia Delaunay work in the genre of modern art itself.

## MATHS

In Maths, we will be looking at how to:

- Present and interpret data in pictograms and bar charts
- Calculate maths stories using tens, hundreds and thousands and multiplication
- Solve word problems using add, subtract, multiply and divide
- Solve word problems involving money
- Find the area and perimeter of a shape
- Compare and ordering angles

## RE

Our RE topic this term is all about how Hindu's worship at home and in the Mandir. Children will look at Hindu symbols and how it represents god in many forms. They will also learn about the many Hindu gods.

## COMPUTING
