ENGLISH

In Writing, Year 3 will be working from two books: 'The Penguin Who Wanted To Find Out' and 'Ice Trap!'

We will start with some performance poetry with Pep the Poet, who you may remember from last year.

We will then write a diary entry, and a narrative based on the books above and a nonchronological report about penguins.

We will be using adverbs, expanded noun phrases and Sound! Clauses, as well as continuing to focus on punctuation.

RE

In RE, Year 3 will be focussing on Jesus. We will be looking at why we do not know how Jesus looked and how people portray him differently. We will also look at how Jesus viewed himself.

GEOGRAPHY

In Geography, Year 3 will be looking at Our World and thinking about the question: Where on Earth are we?

We will locate places on a globe or map, including the equator, continents and oceans and look at the lines of longitude and latitude. This will culminate with us making our own world maps.
