ENGLISH

In Writing, we are going to be looking at multiple genres and writing pieces such as:

- A poem
- A Non-Chronological Report
- A diary
- A Newspaper report

Our topic this term is based on the Titanic. We will be reading extracts from: *The Titanic Detective Agency*.

PSHE
