ENGLISH

We will continue to focus on handwriting with the overall aim to transition to a pen for writing.

We will be writing a range of fiction and non-fiction pieces from a biography about an authors, narratives to writing about the Romans to link in with our History topic.

PSHE

In PSHE, our topic this half term is 'Healthy Me'. Our lessons will explore themes such as healthy friendships, dealing with conflict and peer pressure. We will also examine smoking/vaping and alcohol use.



DT

The DT project this half term is to make a mini greenhouse.

Children will design their greenhouse, choose effective materials and techniques, and evaluate their design and others'.

MATHS

In Maths, we will be looking at how to:

- Present and interpret data in tally and bar charts
- Multiply 3 1-digit numbers
- Multiply 2 and 3-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers
- Divide 2 and 3-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers
- Read time accurate to 5 minutes
- Convert time from analogue to digital
- Calculate perimeter and area of rectilinear shapes

This half term our topic is all about Easter. Children will be learning why Easter is important to Christians.
