Year 6 Spring 2 Curriculum Leaflet

ENGLISH

During English lessons, children will continue to use a range of skills including fronted adverbials, subordinate conjunctions and speech to write for purpose. Children will be completing work based on "Oh Maya gods". This will link to the children's previous history topic of the Maya civilisations.

PE

Friday is Year 6s PE day.

We will be focusing on gymnastics this half term.

Please ensure children come to school dressed in appropriate school PE kit.

SCIENCE

The topic introduces the concept of light travelling in straight lines. It starts by looking at beams of light and how light travels to enable children to understand how we see things. We then apply this to the production of shadows and start to look at how light is reflected.

MATHS

In maths lessons, children will be looking at methods to calculate perimeter, area and volume including compound shapes. Children will then move on to answering one and two step worded question in preparation for the reasoning SATs paper. Children will also learn how to use and apply formulas to answer questions including two-step number machines.

RE

In this unit, we will look at how art can be used to express religious faiths, feelings and ideas.







Preparation for SATs

During our afternoon lessons, children will complete extra grammar and arithmetic lessons based on the results from mock SATs test conducted in school.

HISTORY

In this unit, the children will learn about aspects of political, social and cultural Ancient Greek life. They will focus on some areas in depth, such as the systems of government, religion, and the importance of the Olympic Games. They will examine the legacy of the Ancient Greeks and will have opportunities for further study of areas of interest.
