## Muddy Monday's

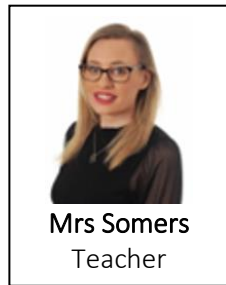

## WB: 17<sup>th</sup> March

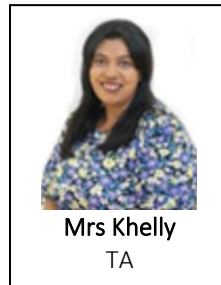
