WB: 24th February

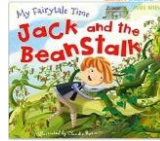
'Farm'.



During this week, we will be learning about different farm animals. We will be taking part in small world activities based around what happens on a farm. We will be drawing and writing about our favourite farm animal.

WB: 3rd March and 10th March

'Jack and the Beanstalk by Miles Kelly'.



During the next two weeks, we will be planting our very own Beanstalk and making sure we look after it. We will be making junk model castles just like where the giant lived. We will be retelling the story and put together the sequence of the story.

WB: 17th March

'Signs of Spring'.



During this week we will be looking for signs of Spring. We will be learning about how the weather changes in Spring and what happens to the trees. In Spring leaves and flowers will start to grow and we start seeing different minibeasts like butterflies and bees.

WB: 24th March and 1st April

During the next two weeks we will observe eggs hatch into chicks. We will make our own diary for the eggs as they hatch and grow. We will be exploring the lifecycle of a chicken.
