

# Year 3 Summer 1 Curriculum Leaflet

## ENGLISH

In our writing lessons Year 3 will be reading 'George's Marvellous Medicine' by Roald Dahl. The children will be using this text to write a list poem and a diary entry.

We will also write a non-chronological report based on our science topic of plants.



## PSHE

In PSHE Year 3 are learning about changes, including puberty.

Children will make a ribbon of changes mobile.



## ART

In art, we will be learning about Seurat and Pointillism. Year 3 will then create a piece of pointillism artwork.



## MATHS

In Maths, Year 3 will be continuing work on fractions. We will be looking at shading the shapes to show the given fractions as well as adding and subtracting fractions. Children will be using their knowledge to solve word problems that include fractions. Year 3 will be practicing their 3, 4 and 8 times tables and using this to solve multiplication and division problems. They will then use this knowledge and apply it to grid multiplication. Children will also be learning how to read both analogue and digital time.

## RE

In RE, children will be learning about the Bible. They will look at how the Bible is used by Christians as well as the different genres covered in both the Old and New Testament.
