

Year 3 Summer 2 Curriculum Leaflet

ENGLISH

In our writing lessons Year 3 will be using *The Iron Man* by Ted Hughes and *Breakfast Club Adventures* by Marcus Rashford as a basis for our diary entry and our newspaper report. We will also use the Weston-Super-Mare trip to write a recount of our day. We will focus on using conjunctions and becoming more consistently accurate with punctuation.

PSHE

In PSHE Year 3 will be thinking about our 'Dreams and Goals.' At the end of the unit children will then create a Garden of Dreams and Goals.



DT

In DT, we are researching British inventions and inventors. We focus on telephones, the internet as well as concrete. We then design a new creation intended to solve a problem.

MATHS

In Maths, Year 3 will be:

- Calculating time durations;
- Adding and subtracting three fractions with the same denominator;
- Solving measure word problems involving all four operations;
- Estimating and measuring mass and volume;
- Comparing measurements;
- Calculating perimeter and
- Interpreting a variety of data

RE

In RE, children will be learning about the Bible. They will look at how the Bible is used by Christians as well as the different genres covered in both the Old and New Testament.
