Year 5 Autumn 1 Curriculum Leaflet

ENGLISH

In Writing, we are going to be looking at multiple genres and writing things such as:

- Character descriptions
- Letter
- Newspaper report

Our class text this half term is The Boy at the Back of the Class by Onjali Rauf

RE

In RE, we are learning about the Christian Bible and where it came from. We are going to be looking at the Bible in detail, the stories within the Bible and comparing the Old Testament and New Testament.

GEOGRAPHY

Geography is all about the changes in our local environment. We will be looking at how the area has changed throughout history, comparing the local area to different places in the UK, and thinking about how the UK will continue to change in the future.

PSHE

During PSHE, children will be looking at being me in my world. This will focus on children's goals and what they want to achieve.



ART

In art, children will be exploring the idea of Chinese art and the different techniques and objects which are used within their paintings.

MUSIC



In music, children will be looking at the piece livin' on a prayer.
Classes will have the opportunity to learn the recorder.

SCIENCE

Science is all about space and planets. Children will be looking at the different planets and then will find more information relating to them. The children will learn about different shadows which can be created and focusing on the solar system.

MATHS

In Maths, children will be looking at a range of topics. These include Place value and reading numbers up to a million, adding 5 digit numbers together using tricky column. Children will be multiplying using 10,100,1000 and including decimals and multiplying numbers using the short methods.

Children will then start by drawing and learning about different properties on angles followed by adding and subtracting negative numbers.

To finish the half term children will look at completing number sequences using square numbers, estimating and finding the area or regular and irregular shapes and investigate reflation and translation in two quadrants.

COMPUTING

Computing is all about designing and making our own games using Scratch! We will be learning about programs and algorithms.
