Year 4 Autumn 1 Curriculum Leaflet

ENGLISH

In writing, we are consolidating the skills taught in Year 4 and building fluency. We are focusing on handwriting letter formation.

We have some interesting texts to explore, from 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' to 'The Magic Finger'.

RE

In RE, we will be looking at the rite of passage for Sikhs. During lessons, children will explore the importance of gurus, Sikh naming ceremonies and the baptism ceremony that Sikhs take part in.

GEOGRAPHY

Geography this term is all about The Americas!

We are learning about Route 66 and where it goes, what is runs though and the different landscapes. We look at different places within North America in detail and start to understand the physical and human characteristics of given locations.

Children will be doing a lot of research and map work.

PSHE

In PSHE, our topic is 'Being Me in My World'. Our lessons will involve teamwork activities, getting to know each other better, and building a class charter. This will be a set of rules we will agree to follow all year long.



ART
