WB: 15th September

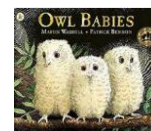
'In My Heart' by Jo Witek

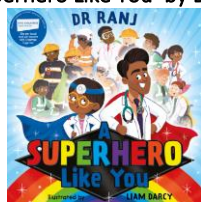
WB: 7th October
