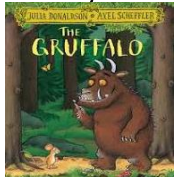


Reception Curriculum Leaflet

WB: 3rd November

'The Gruffalo' by Julia Donaldson.



During this week we will be reading 'The Gruffalo'. We will be thinking about the different animals that live in the wood and start to describe the Gruffalo. We will be painting portraits of the Gruffalo and we will even be cooking Gruffalo crumble. We will then retell the story and order the characters in the woods.

WB: 10th November

'The three little pigs'.

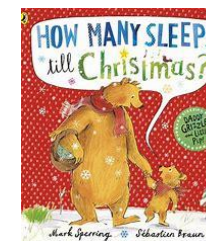
