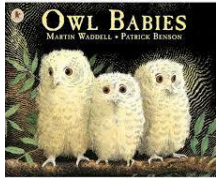


# Nursery Autumn 2 Curriculum Leaflet

3<sup>th</sup> Nov



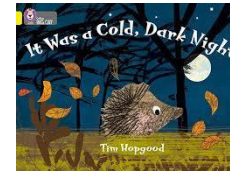
Owl babies will be our first book this half term. We will be learning about where owls live and some facts about Owls. We will learn all about trees and what happens to them and their leaves in Autumn.

10<sup>th</sup> Nov



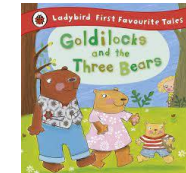

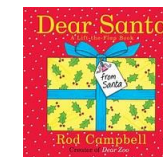
