ENGLISH

In writing, we will be reading and writing about the amazing inventor, Leonora Bolt. Children will develop their already strong skills to create amazing pieces of work. Children will create a setting description, a letter and a story ending.

Children will also continue to build their reading skills by looking in depth at interesting texts during reading lessons.

PSHE

In PSHE, our topic this half term is on Relationships.

Our lessons will explore themes of jealousy, friendships, helping others to feel part of a group as well as showing respect in how we treat others.



Art

Art this half term focus is on the artist Sonia Delaunay.

Children will become familiar with the early life and artwork of Sonia Delaunay. They will learn the influence and legacy of Sonia Delaunay work in the genre of modern art itself.

MATHS

In Maths, we will be looking at how to:

- Recognising the place value of digits up to 2 decimal places.
- Solve decimals and fraction maths stories.
- Calculate fractions of quantities of shapes.
- Classify shapes.
- Solve word problems involving fractions.

RE

Our RE topic this term is all about how Hindu's worship at home and in the Mandir. Children will look at Hindu symbols and how it represents god in many forms. They will also learn about the many Hindu gods.
