## ENGLISH

In Writing, we are going to be looking at multiple genres and writing things such as:

- Poetry
- Playscripts
- Diary entry

Our class text this half term is The Final Year by Matt Goodfellow.

## RE

In RE, our key question is: Why is Muhammad important to Muslims?

We are going to be learning about Muhammad and why he is an important role model to Muslims around the world.

## HISTORY
