ENGLISH

In Writing, we are going to be looking at multiple genres and writing pieces such as:

- Dialogue
- A short story
- A discussion text

Our focus book this half term is *The Eye of the Wolf* by Daniel Pennac.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be looking at the topic of relationships. During this topic we will look at important such as mental health and the impact this has on us and the people around us and the role that social media plays in our lives children will also investigate ways to stay safe online.



ART

Children will be creating clay vases this term. They will study the work of other professionals, gain an understanding of the different types of vases: their shapes, patterns, sizes and the materials used to make them. They will then mould and create vases. Once made they will paint them using various techniques learnt throughout the term.

MATHS

In Maths this half term, we will be looking at a range of skills to help us with our preparation for SATS. This will include:

- Time Duration
- Area of compound shapes
- Perimeter of compound shapes
- Converting between measures, including word problems

At some point, Year 6 will start offering Maths Boosters in the mornings.

RE

Our key question in RE this term is: What is the Qur'an and why is it important to Muslims? Children will find out what the Qur'an is and how Muslims follow the teachings in it to live their lives. We will also be delving into where Muslims worship and some of the key teachings within the Qur'an.

COMPUTING
