

Year 3 Autumn 2 Curriculum Leaflet

ENGLISH

This term, we will be diving into the imaginative world of *The Iron Man* by Ted Hughes. This exciting text will inspire a variety of writing activities, including character descriptions, story retells, persuasive letters, and newspaper reports. Through these tasks, children will explore themes of mystery, bravery and friendship, while developing their own creative voices.

Our writing focus will continue to be on using punctuation accurately and confidently, and enriching sentences with adjectives, adverbs and conjunctions. We look forward to seeing the children's ideas come to life on the page!

PSHE

In PSHE we will be 'Celebrating Difference.' At the end of the unit children will then create a Compliment Kite for the 'Hall of Fame'.



DT

In Design and Technology, we will design, make, and evaluate a storybook with moving mechanisms.



MATHS

This term in Maths, we will be developing their problem-solving skills and deepening their understanding of key mathematical concepts. Pupils will practise solving multiplication and division word problems using the 3-, 4- and 8-times tables. They will also explore geometry by drawing, naming and describing the properties of both 2D and 3D shapes. Later in the term, children will apply their knowledge of addition, subtraction to solve word problems involving numbers up to 1000.

Throughout the term, we will continue to focus on building mathematical reasoning - applying strategies to tackle challenges with confidence.

RE

In RE we will be looking at Diwali. They will be learning about the story of Rama and Sita, as well as divas, their importance and rangoli patterns.
