ENGLISH

In writing, we will continue to be working on our handwriting. We will also be looking to add conjunctions into our work as well as adjectives to help our work become even better!

We will also be shown a range of different stories throughout this term which will help us with our writing tasks.

MUSIC

In Music we will be learning to perform the song 'Your imagination' using a range of skills taught throughout the term



GEOGRAPHY

In this topic, children will explore a range of habitats around the world, including oceans, deserts, rainforests and polar regions. They will learn to describe what these environments are like and identify the animals that live there. Children will also begin to understand how animals are suited to their habitats and how they survive in different conditions.

PSHE

ART

We will be looking at a range of skills to create a self-portrait. We will be creating simple collages, using a range of pencil techniques, and manipulating clay.

We will continue to look at recognising and writing numbers to 100, addition and subtraction as well as introducing the children to multiplication and division. We will also be looking at doubling and halving. As well as this, we will be looking at time and number bonds to 20.
