

Year 3 Summer 1 Curriculum Leaflet

ENGLISH

Our writing this term will be inspired by *How to Survive an Apocalypse* by Coby Coonradt, Cameron Hardy and Neon Squid. We will explore three exciting genres:

Letter

- Children will write a letter to anybody that survived the apocalypse. They will focus on giving advice (both what to do and what not to do) as well as giving information about what has happened.

Setting Description

- Children will use lots of descriptive writing to describe what the world is like after an apocalypse.

Non-Chronological Report

- Children will use subheadings to organise their writing to inform others on how to survive an apocalypse. They will focus on what equipment may be needed and how they can stay safe.

PSHE

In PSHE Year 3 are learning about changes they will face in life, including puberty.

Children will be making a ribbon of changes mobile to show what they have learnt.

ART

In art, we will be learning about Seurat and Pointillism. Year 3 will then create a piece of pointillism artwork.



MATHS

In Maths, Year 3 will be continuing work on fractions. We will be looking at shading the shapes to show the given fractions as well as adding and subtracting fractions. Children will be using their knowledge to solve word problems that include fractions. Year 3 will be practicing their 3, 4 and 8 times tables and using this to solve multiplication and division problems. They will then use this knowledge and apply it to grid multiplication. Children will also be learning how to read both analogue and digital time.

RE

In RE, children will be learning about the Bible. They will look at how the Bible is used by Christians as well as the different genres covered in both the Old and New Testament.
