ENGLISH

In Writing, we are going to be looking finishing the book Cogheart and creating a missing poster.

We will then look at a book all about the Vikings. We will be creating a non-chronological report of what we have learnt.

PSHE

This half term, we will be working on 'Changing Me.' This will focus on the circles of change looking at both girls and boys and the human body.



ART

MATHS

In Maths, we are going to be looking at:

- Ordering and comparing decimals
